Dear President,

the conferment of the "Antonio Feltrinelli" Prizes, established by testamentary disposition of Dr. Antonio Feltrinelli, is one of the most prestigious activities of our Academy: the prizes are of great importance not only for the significant remuneration that is awarded, but mainly for the outstanding achievements of the prize recipients.

To continue our pursuit to honor great accomplishments, the submission of numerous valid nominations to our Prize Committees is essential. I therefore kindly ask for your support in identifying worth candidates for the Prizes listed below.

I am pleased to inform you that the 2025 **«Antonio Feltrinelli» Prizes**, will be awarded specifically:

- six International Prizes reserved to both Italians and foreigners, in the amount of  $\in$  100.000 each (gross amount before tax deductions) in the field of:
  - Philology and Linguistics;
  - **Philosophical Sciences** (not conferred in 2024);
  - Astronomy;
  - Classical Philology;
  - Cinema;
  - Medicine.
- four National Prizes reserved to Italian citizens, in the amount of  $\in$  65.000 each (gross amount before tax deductions) in the fields of:
  - Economy and Society;
  - Law Sciences;
  - Philosophical Sciences;
  - History.
  - ten National Prizes entitled «Antonio Feltrinelli Giovani» will be awarded:

**five** in the fields of:

- Archeology;
- Law Sciences;
- Social Sciences;
- Philology and Linguistics;
- Arts.

**five** in the fields of:

- Mathematics, Mechanics and Applications;
- Biological Sciences;
- Chemistry;
- Information Sciences:
- One Health.

These national prizes **«Antonio Feltrinelli Giovani»**, in the amount of  $\in$  50.000 each (gross amount before tax deductions), will be awarded to Italian scholars - under the age of 40 on 31 October 2024 – for work that represents a significant and original contribution in the respective prize category.

We are aware that in many Universities outside Italy there are remarkable scholars of Italian Nationality and therefore we are confident that you might submit proposals beyond the international prizes.

Nominations may be submitted by the Lincei Fellows and the Presidents and Fellow of Italian and Foreign Academies (*Nomination form attached*).

The deadline to submit nominations, by e-mail to: <u>ufficio.premi@lincei.it</u>, is <u>31 October</u> <u>2024</u> (*date of e-mail*). Nominations must be accompanied by the nominee's curriculum vitae, list of publications and a detailed statement of his/her scientific achievements.
